What are the ingredients?

Aloe Vera reduces inflammation, decreases swelling and accelerates wound healing. Aids in keeping the skin supple and relieves itching due to insect bites and allergies. Helps increase the availability of oxygen to the skin and increase the synthesis and strength of tissue.

Witch Hazel possesses anti-inflammatory properties, helps stop bleeding, eases pain and itching, creates a barrier against infection, and speeds healing.

Lavender Essential Oil provides a fresh, calming aroma, aids in wound healing and rejuvenates the skin. *NOTE* FIRST AID FOR DOGS CONTAINS LAVENDER ESSENTIAL OIL; FIRST AID FOR CATS DOES NOT. ESSENTIAL OILS SHOULD NOT BE USED ON CATS!

What if my pet licks it off?

The ingredients in First Aid were selected because they are safe even if ingested by pets. We have used food-grade, organic Aloe Vera and alcohol-free Witch Hazel. While Witch Hazel can be taken internally, the distillate preparation used in this product is for external use; however, because it is alcohol-free, a small amount licked off by your pet will not cause harm. Lavender may also be taken internally, although preferably not in the essential oil form; however, the quantity of oil present in our formula is quite small and will not harm your dog if licked off in small amounts. **If you have a cat, please look for *First Aid for Cats*, which does not contain any essential oils.**

Is First Aid painful for my pet?

First Aid does not contain alcohol and therefore will not burn, bubble or otherwise irritate your pet's skin or ears. Our extremely gentle formula is designed to soothe and comfort without any stinging or pain.

Can I use First Aid on myself?

First Aid is perfectly safe and effective for use by humans. Try it for poison ivy/oak rashes and mosquito bites, as well as minor burns, cuts and scrapes.
